- ii. Number of 2008 registrations, processed as paper via snail mail, with checks: 336
- iii. Number of 2008 registrations processed via direct swimmer entries to USMS using credit cards; 19
- iv. Number of 2008 regs vs 2007 regs, as of end of January: 355:422 The difference is probably due to
 - 1. the fee increase and
 - lack of a hardcopy mailing requesting renewal by 2007 swimmers who have not yet renewed via email request. There was a promise to provide the mailing at the end of December, but nothing seems to have happened. I will contact the provider for the mailing again. There are currently 362 non-renewals remaining from 2007, out of a total 635 registrations for 2007(= 43% renewal rate).
- v. On-line registration by individual swimmers is currently suspended, until 2/04/08 AM. This is intended to provide a clean "break" for the Jan '08 financial processing. This break should not be necessary in succeeding months for the rest of 2008.
- vi. Currently there are 30 2008 hardcopy subscriptions, yielding a 8.5% hard copy subscription rate for 2008 registered swimmers, compared to 8.4% at the end of 2007.
- vii. On-line registration process comments:
 - 1. The financial reports are good, detailing both USMS and LMSC reg fees and donations. \$ transfers are currently required for both USMS -> LMSC(individual on-line regs), and LMSC -> USMS(paper to LMSC registrar).
 - 2. Currently, only a registrar can print member cards; CA(the Computer Assistant software) promises that individuals will be able to print their own cards sometime in the future.
 - 3. CA has provided a report in the format of the "rsind..." files used by LeoWare, to enable continuation of reporting based on the old software formats. This is especially important during the transition period to the on-line software.
 - 4. Card printing using CA software and window envelopes is working well. Print control using Adobe Acrobat gives very good results.
- viii. The "member since" field in the on-line database needs to be updated the values from 2007 were not carried through until approximately mid-January(about 300 records). I will do the updates to the on-line database and provide a report by the end of next week, but it will have to be checked for accuracy before the banquet.
